

Bodysuit for Blythe

This outfit needs to be made of stretchy fabric. Place the fabric so that the garment will stretch most sideways (just try and see which way the fabric stretches most).

This pattern makes a bodysuit, which has a fairly tight body and a bit looser legs. Add more seam allowance to make the outfit a bit looser or make the legs narrower for really tight fitting bodysuit.

1. Fold the fabric and place the edge marked "Fold" on the fold. Cut two pieces.
2. Place the pieces right sides together and sew the middle seam (long curved part on the right of the pattern) all the way on one side and about 1/3 from the crotch up on the other side.
3. Turn the piece so that this seam is in the middle and the seam allowances are on the outside. Fit the piece on the doll, if you have difficulties in figuring this out. The important thing is that when you sew the shoulder seams, the pieces are right sides together.
4. Sew the shoulder seams.
5. Hem the sleeves and legs.
6. Sew the side seams.
7. Finish the back opening and neck.
8. Attach buttons or snaps as desired.
