Long-sleeve dress for Petworks Nikki

The pattern should be printed on A4 paper. If Letter size is used, make sure the pages are not resized during printing.



This dress does not have lining and the seam allowances in the patterns are only 1-2 mm as you should use fabric that does not fray easily or treat the edges with Fray Stop or other similar fabric glue. The pictures shown on the fabric here are iron-on transfers. If you want to use those, iron them on the fabric after cutting the front piece, but before sewing any seams.

Instructions:

Cut the pieces. The sleeves are a bit long as you can see in the photo. Adjust their length as desired.

Sew the shoulder seams. There are two options for sewing the sleeves: 1) Sew the side seams and sleeve seams separately and then sew the sleeves in place, or 2) sew the sleeves in place and then sew the side and sleeve seams as one seam. Finally, sew the back seam under the tail.

Sew buttons or snaps in the places indicated in the pattern for closing the back.
